## What is the purpose of a resume?

- To introduce you to someone specific
- To present relevant information and accomplishments from your background

#### Sections of a resume

- Objective Statement / Summary (optional)
- Experience
- Education
- Skills
- Professional Associations

### What makes a resume effective?

- Professionally written no mistakes!
- It looks good
- It proves you can do the job
- It's relevant

## The Tao of Resume™ Task...Action...Outcome

Every line on your resume should include the following:

**T**ask: What you did

**A**ction: How you did it

Outcome: Proof that you did a good job

Forward

- Won several basketball awards
- ✓ Named to the NBA all-rookie team
- ✓ Selected to the NBA all-star team five times
- ✓ Led the Denver Nuggets to two division titles and the conference finals (2009)
- ✓ Won a gold medal at the 2008 Olympics

#### Carmelo's Resume

#### **Carmelo Anthony**

#### **New York Knicks**

Forward

- Increased assists per game
- ✓ Increased assists per game 47% between 2008 and 2012 by studying game footage, participating in 100% of team practices and working with a personal trainer in the off-season

## Resume Writing Practice #1: Marketing Writer

Task...Action...Outcome

#### Before:

Wrote case study

#### After:

 Wrote 20-page case study and directed a three-minute corporate video used by the company's CSO and international sales teams to secure government contracts in the U.S., China, Norway and Singapore (\$50MM total)

# Resume Writing Practice #2: IT Project Manager

Task...Action...Outcome

#### Before:

Shortened time needed to install software

#### After:

 Reduced labor costs by \$2K per month and shortened average length of software installations from 25 to 12 hours through effective implementation of off-hour installations and use of a flexible, part-time workforce.

## **Your Resume and Telecommuting**

  - Partial / part-time telecommuting
  - Option for telecommuting
